The 2019 A. Muse Rosé is a Sauvignon Blanc (with 10% Mouhtaro), unoaked, very dry and coming in at 12.7% alcohol. I'm trying to think of the last time I saw a Sauvignon Blanc cast as a Rosé—I can't remember one. This, nonetheless, might well be the most successful of the white grapes featured by the producer this issue. Textured with a little silk, it is reasonably substantial, fresh and has some personality. It isn't a high personality pink, though; the Sauvignon remains a bit muted here, which will suit many just fine. It still provides this wine with both personality and freshness. It's a pleasure to drink, and it should still be fine this coming summer. I wouldn't age it much longer than that, no matter how long it theoretically lasts. Freshness is what this is all about.
